Further investments into digitalisation, artificial intelligence and robotics, and improvement of citizens' digital literacy and digital competence. Support the development of 'smart' cities and villages.

Effective protection of Europe's external borders with the latest technology, including drones. Set up a European Cyber Brigade within two years.

Establish a true Energy Union, where electricity and gas can cross borders without obstacles. Support cost-effective expansion of renewable energies and low-carbon mobility.

Create five million new jobs by increasing economic growth through more trade and better support for SMEs. Training, education, life-long learning and equal opportunities for women in the labour market.



Socialists and Democrats

Long-term Investment Plan to prepare EU's industries and workers so they benefit from the green transition, the digital revolution and the growth of artificial intelligence.

Pledge for further development of common European defence (pooling and sharing our resources to ensure peace and security), as well as maintaining effective control of all external borders while fighting human trafficking.

Make the EU a leader in renewable energies and become climate-neutral by 2050. CO<sup>2</sup> emissions should be taxed EU-wide.

Modernise the economy and the labour market to fit changing conditions, such as the green transition, the digital revolution and the growth of artificial intelligence. Assist young people to find a quality job, traineeship or further education, by extending the European Youth Guarantee.



Alliance of Liberals and Democrats for Europe

Create a solid legal framework for new technologies such as blockchain and artificial intelligence. Security: every European should get a trusted and secure digital identity to be able to log in and sign documents safely.

More effective efforts to secure the EU's external border: European Border and Coast Guard as an effective EU border-guard service. Upgrade Europol's powers and increasing cooperation in intelligence sharing.

Reduce greenhouse gas emissions by 55% by 2030. Transition towards more zero-emission vehicles and self-driving vehicles.

Bridge the digital skills gap and foster labour mobility among Member States. Life-long learning and inclusion of women in the labour market.



European Left

Promote digital democracy, Internet neutrality and freedom of speech.

Social investments rather than military operations (PESCO and FRONTEX).

Invest in low-cost and green solutions to tackle energy poverty. Prevent the privatisation of natural resources. Make the production and distribution of energy public.

Reduce unemployment by strengthening the welfare state, improving working conditions and introducing self-managed factories.



European Greens

More investment in innovation and smart solutions, making products and processes more energy- and resource-efficient. Seize the opportunities of digitisation, artificial intelligence and robotisation.

Heavy investment in civilian conflict-prevention, mediation, reconciliation and peacekeeping. Oppose redirecting European funds towards military purposes. Further cooperation in a common security and defence policy.

Phase out coal and other fossil fuels by 2030. Nuclear power and fracking have no role to play in the clean energy future. Advance towards zero-emission vehicles.

Support life-long learning and career changes with an effective implementation of the European Youth Guarantee. Create jobs by investing in renewable energy sources and sustainable farming.
